## REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING BLUE CROSS PLAN 65 MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT PREMIUM RATES

Notice is hereby given that the Rhode Island Office of the Health Insurance Commissioner ("OHIC") will accept written public comment until Friday, October 5, 2007 regarding a filing for an increase in premium rates for individual Plan 65 Medicare Supplement subscribers submitted by Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Rhode Island ("Blue Cross") on August 10, 2007 ("the Filing"). The Filing proposes the following premium rate increases effective February 1, 2008: a 4.4% rate increase for Plan 65 Medigap Plan A, a 6.0% rate increase for Plan 65 Medigap Plans B and C, a 3.5% rate increase for Plan 65 Select B, a 9.0% rate increase for Plan 65 Select C, and a 1.7% rate increase for Plan 65 Select L.
